



## Recycle your Used Oil and Oil Filters

1. Place used oil into container and drain oil filters for 24 hours.
2. Place oil filters into a plastic bag or bucket for transportation.
3. Bring used oil container and filters to a Certified Used Oil Recycling Center during their normal business hours.

### DO NOT mix oil with the following:

|          |             |               |
|----------|-------------|---------------|
| Water    | Anti-Freeze | Varnishes     |
| Gasoline | Brake Fluid | Degreaser     |
| Kerosene | Paint       | Paint Thinner |

*(Contaminated Oil cannot be recycled and is considered Household Hazardous Waste. HHW is collected by ERL on select drop-off days.)*
