Pick one up at Truckee Town Hall, or at one of Truckee's Certified Used Oil Recycling Centers.\*




## Did You Know ~ Used Oil Can Be Recycled

Your motor vehicle, gardening and recreational equipment oil can be recycled into usable motor oil and lubricant. Your oil filter can be recycled into rebar.



It takes 42 gallons of crude oil, but only 1 gallon of used oil, to produce 2.5 quarts of new, high-quality lubricant.



# ♥ OUR LANDS USE THE KIT

## **Free!** Kits Include:

### 11-quart Oil Container

Place used oil into container and drain oil filters for 24 hours. Place oil filters in a plastic bag or bucket.\*

### Oil-only Mat

Use when fueling or changing oil to prevent spills and water pollution. If a spill occurs on land, rain transports chemicals through storm drains directly to our waters! Place in a plastic bag.\*

### Oil Funnel

Wipe with Oil-only Mat provided. (Do NOT use water!)
