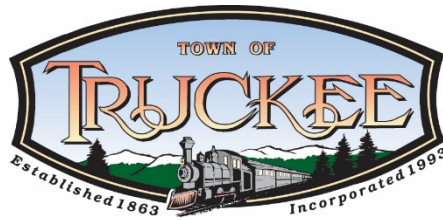

To Lodging Purveyors:

March 24, 2020 3pm

Today the Nevada County Health Officer clarified the California Governor's Stay at Home Order as it relates to hotels, motels, and condominiums single family homes rented for 30 days or less, and other units.

The clarification states that the ONLY allowed use of these facilities is for the housing of workers who are specifically allowed under the Governor's orders defining workers performing functions that are essential to critical infrastructure. A list of those is here:

The only other allowed use is to provide quarantine facilities or to house displaced persons, which does not include housing people who have voluntarily left their homes.

The County Health Office further clarified that all persons residing in the state remain in their homes or place of residence.

Based on this directive, the Town of Truckee is requesting that all short term rental activity (defined as a stay of 30 days or less in a hotel, residence or other facility), cease except for providing quarantine facilities or to house displaced persons. No reservations for short term rental or hotel rooms should be accepted for a period of 60 days, ending May 23, 2020. This date may be extended. Existing reservations should be canceled and occupants removed within 48 hours. The Truckee Police Department can issue citations for violations of the County Health Officer's order.

This order will stay in place until rescinded by the County Health Officer.

We recognize these new changes in lodging requirement are yet another impact to your business and employees. We appreciate your willingness to cooperate during these challenging times to keep our communities safe. We value our local businesses and we look forward to welcoming our visitors back at a future date.
